Teacher Sick Days

Right now is a new and scary time for all of us, one in which illnesses have a whole new level of fear surrounding them. Due to this, we want to inform you of our process for when a teacher is sick. We will treat a teacher being sick just like an illness in any other year until we have knowledge of whether or not they have COVID. We want to recognize that there are other illnesses going around and want teachers, as well as community members, to have the time and space to recover. As with any other year, when a teacher is sick, we will work hard to find coverage for their class so students can continue to have as normal of a day as possible. It is only in extreme circumstances that we would ask students to stay home and be virtual for the day. If this is to happen, admin will communicate that with families. Should a member of the community test positive for COVID, the community will be notified as soon as is possible (within just a couple hours in most circumstances).
