From Gifted and Talented (GT) - If you would like your student to test for Magnet eligibility please visit this website and sign your child up for the COGAT test. On the website, look under the headline "Interested in Magnet Testing" and nominate your child. This must be completed by 10/14. If you have further questions please email jennifer cessar@dpsk12.org. If your child is in Kindergarten or 2nd, you do not need to sign your child up for this testing. These students will take the NNAT (a nonverbal, cognitive test) this Fall.
