## **REMINDER Mask Update**

On Wednesday, the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment <u>announced</u> that the public health order requiring masks in schools will expire at the end of the day on Friday, Feb. 25. Masks are still required in all indoor school settings until that date. The decision by DDPHE means that, beginning Monday, Feb. 28, masks will no longer be required but will be strongly recommended for all students, staff, and visitors across DPS.

## **REMINDER Summer Options**

We are hearing from a lot of parents that they are feeling confused about options for their child this summer. We are hoping we can help clarify some of that here.

- **Summer Connections** is the DPS summer *school* option, where students will work on literacy, math, and science. ## News from Classrooms

**2nd Grade:** The second graders will begin a new literacy and science unit learning all about the different cycles in nature. Some topics we are covering are the seasons, daytime and nighttime cycles, the life cycles of frogs and butterflies, and the water cycle. We will be working like scientists observing and recording our observations of the butterfly cycle in class. We will be building our science vocabulary as well as doing our learning through becoming efficient users of nonfiction texts and writing like scientists in journals.


